

Short Vowel Marker - ff, ll, ss, zz

In a one syllable word, double the final f, l, s, and z after a single short vowel. Some people call this the fizzles rule. Others call it Sam Likes Fried Zebras (s,l,f,z).

Exceptions - if, clef gas, this us, thus, yes, bus, plus

Note: Final -s sounded as /z/ is never doubled - as, is, was, has, his
